



## SUMMER EXHIBITION 2008: INVITATION

### The Exhibition

The 2<sup>nd</sup> annual SUMMER EXHIBITION will be held at the New York Academy of Art. This public presentation of art by our M.F.A. students, past and present, will remain on view through the entire summer, extending from 17 June to 7 September 2008. To enter work for SUMMER EXHIBITION 2008, please follow these instructions:

### Entries

Each artist is entitled to submit a maximum of three works. Initial submission of works will be done by jpeg only, sent by the artist to the Academy at [summerexhibition@nyaa.edu](mailto:summerexhibition@nyaa.edu). Please send low resolution jpegs (72 dpi, no larger than 700 pixels tall).

- All submissions are **required** to use the following label format for each jpeg:
  - LastName\_FirstName\_TitleofPiece\_Dimensions.jpeg
  - \* **please remember to include the file extension (.jpg)**
- In the subject line of the email please type your:
  - Last Name, First Name, Middle Initial
- In the body of your email, we ask that you please include (in this order)
  - Last name, First name, middle initial
  - Mailing address
  - Daytime telephone number
  - Email address
  - Year of graduation

For each work submitted:

- Title
- Medium and dimensions
- Date
- Price
- Any gallery affiliations

All entries must be sent electronically by **29 April 2008**. Once that is complete artists may choose to bring works for physical review by the Selection Committee on 6 May 2008, between the hours of 11am - 1pm. Once selected for exhibition, it is the responsibility of the artist to safely deliver the work to the Academy between June 2 - 9, 2008 and retrieve unsold work(s) by Sunday, 14 September 2008.

### Sales of Art Work

All works will be available for purchase. Artists will receive 75% of the net proceeds from the sale of their work; the Academy will retain a 25% commission in support of Academy scholarships and year-round programs. Payment for purchase by check, credit card or cash is acceptable.

### Exhibition Requirements

All exhibited works must remain on display until the show closes at 6 pm on Sunday, 7 September 2008.

### Framing

Two-dimensional work to be displayed **must arrive** ready for hanging, with all the necessary hardware, and if needed, framed. Three dimensional work should arrive with a pedestal.

### Copyright

Under the Copyright Act, it is the general rule that, in the absence of any agreement to the contrary, copyright in a work of art belongs to the artist, or his or her heirs and assigns.
